






Simplicity, Durability, Efficiency

The tools we make are conceived and constructed with an eye for simplicity, durability, and efficiency. For Petzl, being a pioneer has meant 50 years of passion, expertise, innovation, and continuous improvement. This approach to our craft and our business has allowed us to serve as a global expert, as we did in 2006 with the conception of the EXO personal escape system. At the request of, and in collaboration with, the firefighters of New York City, we were able to design an efficient solution that would allow easy escape in critical situations. 3. Industrial Excellence






Beyond the Standards

We have a deep responsibility to the people who trust us with their lives, and we develop, test, and qualify all of our products above required standards. Our design center, based in France, integrates all crafts that are related to the creation of products: mechanical, textile, electronic, optical, and technological. From the design and prototype phases, the reliability of a product and the safety of the user are continuously evaluated, with particular attention to risks of use.

With labs dedicated to product testing, we conduct dynamic fall and impact resistance tests, perform cyclical testing, and evaluate performance, as well as beam quality and burn times of our headlamps. This process includes rigorous field testing in order to test the ergonomics and reliability during real-world use.





Zero Defects - PPE (Personal Protective Equipment)

Reliability is at the center of our concerns: our goal is for our products to consistently function at the same level of excellence. Our objective is to allow zero defective products to leave our facilities, which involves processes with significant extra costs at every stage of production.

As we navigate an increasingly globalized economy, we go to great lengths to support our distributors and dealers, and we are heavily involved in the fight against counterfeit products.

Production and Inspection

Petzl's production sites are located in France, in the towns of Crolles, Eybens, and Rotherens, as well as in Rawang, Malaysia.

Remaining competitive and keeping the majority of our production in France means that we continuously optimize our production lines and reduce our waste. This production infrastructure is complemented by long-term partnerships with key suppliers in Europe and Asia.

Our purchasing and quality control teams work closely with suppliers, ensuring to the best of our abilities, product reliability and quality that meets or exceeds our strict requirements. Quality inspection is present throughout every step of the production process: machine inspection of operations, human inspection at key points, further reinforcement by error-proofing systems and final individual inspection of each product.

We regularly audit the methods, quality management systems, and CSR practices (Corporate Social Responsibility) of our suppliers and strategic partners, especially when it comes to their employees.

Sharing technical knowledge and appropriate product uses is at the heart of what we do at Petzl. We produce high-quality technical content that is available to everyone and utilized by the different communities that we serve. With a focus on maximizing safety, this content is updated and enriched throughout the lifespan of our products to keep our customers informed and moving forward while they practice their sport or do their job.

Across the world, we have partnerships with iconic athletes, influential figures, professionals who work in extreme conditions, NGOs, certifying bodies, and training centers operated by leading experts in the field. Four Actionable Commitments

At Petzl, we're focused on four commitments that respond to the primary concerns of over 2,000 of our internal stakeholders (employees, subsidiaries, family shareholders) and external stakeholders (clients, users, suppliers, associations, and NGOs). We are manifesting these four commitments through hands-on projects with measurable outcomes.

Reduce Our Carbon Footprint

In 2020, we worked with Carbone 4 to measure the comprehensive carbon impact of our operations in 2019 — from the extraction of raw materials to the end of a product's life.

Our footprint was equal to 45,000 metric tons of CO². Three areas accounted for 75 % of our emissions: raw materials (34 %), transport of goods (24 %), energy used to power our headlamps (17 %).

In 2021, we created initiatives to reduce our carbon footprint: prioritize the use of materials with the least impact, improve the durability and repairability of our products, shrink the distances our goods travel, and reduce our energy consumption.

By 2030, our goal is to reduce our total carbon footprint by 50 % per euro in sales.





Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle Our Waste

The waste from our industrial and commercial operations produces a variety of pollutants.

We're taking action in our factories, warehouses, and offices to reach three objectives by 2025:

- Eliminate single-use plastics in our packaging and supply chain
- Reuse 50 % of our cardboard and palettes, recycle the rest
- Recycle 80 % of our metal, plastic, cardboard and wood waste, put the rest towards energy recovery







Improve Our Employee Satisfaction

Our strong and consistent growth, coupled with the complex issues of the pandemic, has the potential to affect employee health. In 2021, we evaluated the satisfaction of all Petzl employees in France using the Wittyfit platform. The survey covers topics including organization and work load, autonomy, work/life balance, recognition, as well as purpose and values.

Using the results, we created action plans to improve satisfaction — some carried out by leadership and others co-created and led by the teams.

In 2023, this satisfaction audit will be extended to all Petzl employees on a global level.





Improve the Labor Conditions of Our Suppliers

Since 2010, our responsible purchasing initiative has aimed to ensure that all our suppliers comply with the Petzl code of conduct. This code aligns with International Labor Organization (ILO) directives:

Our objectives are to improve social, environmental, health, and safety practices at all of our suppliers.

We've created an annual evaluation of CSR practices for suppliers representing 80 % of our purchases. We've offered reinforced support for 25 % of our suppliers in their continued improvement plans.

We are also collaborating with other manufacturers to combine our audit efforts and reaffirm our CSR standards for common suppliers.

Petzl harnesses are designed to meet the needs of all those who play in the vertical world, whether it's for climbing, mountaineering, via ferrata, canyoning, or caving. We offer a variety of models suited for different body types and different uses.

Designs for different body types:

- With adjustable leg loops, suitable for most body types and all seasons (winter and summer use).
- Without adjustable leg loops, making it lightweight and optimizing freedom of movement.
- Women's harness with angled waistbelt and an adapted rise and waistbelt-to-leg-loop ratio.

Capacity to carry gear suited to the activity:

- For gym climbing, via ferrata, glacier travel, or classic mountaineering, two gear loops are sufficient.


Petzl Harness Technology

For certain climbing and mountaineering harnesses, Petzl uses specific technologies: FRAME, ENDOFRAME, FUSEFRAME, or WIREFRAME. These constructions, which never sacrifice climber comfort, are adapted to different expectations that climbers may have, whether you're just starting out, an active climber, or looking for high performance.



FRAME Technology

This construction forms the core of CORAX and OUISTITI harnesses and combines a thick layer of foam with central webbing on the waistbelt and leg loops. The load is distributed by the webbing that is surrounded by foam. This construction allows for great durability and comfort when hanging for long periods on a climb.




ENDOFRAME Technology



This construction method uses thin foam and specific variable-width webbing sewn onto the foam for optimal load distribution.

The waistbelt webbing is wider at the hips, providing support while remaining lightweight. We've paid careful attention to provide maximum comfort and greatly reduce pressure points or hot spots on the waistbelt. ENDOFRAME technology is used in SAMA, SELENA, ADJAMA, LUNA, and MACCHU harnesses.





• The DISCOVER range is ideal if you're new to the sport or only use the harness occasionally for climbing or activities in the mountains. These harnesses are comfortable when hanging for long periods of time and adapt to different body types.





This gives the harnesses a smooth and clean exterior surface without adding thickness, for improved abrasion resistance. FUSEFRAME technology gives the HIRUNDOS, AQUILA, and FLY harnesses (removable foam) a clean, smart design that is light and comfortable.



WIREFRAME Technology



WIREFRAME technology uses high-modulus polyethylene (HMPE) strands. These strands are used in the waistbelt and leg loops to optimally distribute pressure, ensuring maximum comfort and freedom of movement for the climber. This construction gives the harness an exceptional weight-to-comfort ratio that makes it practically unnoticeable when worn. WIREFRAME technology, applied to a very sleek design with very slim technical lines, is perfectly suited to high-performance SITTA and ALTITUDE harnesses.

With protection against falling objects (EN 12492) and enhanced protection against lateral, front, or rear impact (Petzl's TOP AND SIDE PROTECTION label), Petzl helmets effectively protect the head during numerous activities: climbing, mountaineering, and now ski touring, where wearing a helmet is not yet the norm.

What are the different requirements for a ski touring helmet?


Ventilation:

In ski touring, the physical effort generated on the climb is considerable and requires appropriate gear. Only a lightweight, and most importantly, ventilated helmet can be comfortably worn from beginning to end of an outing.

Head Protection:

Throughout a ski touring day, climbing or descending, the skier may face any of the following risks:

- Rockfall:



As in mountaineering, the skier may be exposed to rock or icefall, for example when climbing a couloir.

- Side, front, and rear impacts:



A fall while climbing on a steep or frozen slope above a rocky outcrop.



A fall while descending caused by terrain hazards: rocks, trees, ice blocks, crevasses, avalanches, or other possible hazards.

The best balance of ventilation and protection for the head will encourage participants to wear a helmet from beginning to end of an outing.

Why has Petzl pursued the creation of a new CE certification for ski touring helmets?

Currently there is no reference standard outlining the health and safety requirements for a ski touring helmet, unlike downhill skiing, which follows the guidelines of the EN 1077 class B standard.

Therefore, in order to obtain CE certification for a helmet used for ski touring, Petzl approached a certifying body to create a standard that takes into consideration the practice, the environment, and the dangers of ski touring.

This reference standard is based primarily on:

- The requirements of the mountaineering helmet standard (EN 12492), to provide rockfall protection, as well as maximum ventilation for comfort during ascents.
- Requirements for enhanced protection against lateral, front, and rear impacts (as described in the Petzl test protocol for the TOP AND SIDE PROTECTION label).

This reference standard is the PCSR (Protocol for ski touring helmets). It is public and available to other manufacturers for certification of their helmets.





Dynamic Ropes

Single Ropes ①

Ropes used as a single strand. These are mainly used for single-pitch climbing. Some climbers also use them for multi-pitch climbing or mountaineering.

Half @ and Twin @ Ropes

These are certified to two types of the CE EN 892 standard.

- Half Ropes: ropes used in pairs that may be clipped separately or together during progression. They are recommended for rappels and to facilitate rope drag management. They provide a back-up in case one of the strands is damaged by a falling rock or a sharp edge.
- Twin Ropes: ropes used in pairs that, unlike half ropes, must always be clipped together during progression. They are recommended for rappels.

Multi-Type Ropes

Multi-type ropes are certified to three types of the CE EN 892 standard. They may be used as a single, half, or twin rope.

Low Stretch Kernmantle Ropes

Low stretch kernmantle ropes have low elongation and are very resistant to abrasion. They are designed for caving, canyoning, rope ascent, or hauling, as well as for route development.







Ice Axe Use and Standards

Each ice axe features characteristics that are specific to its use on the certain terrain, including length, as well as shaft and pick shape.


Standards

In terms of standards, ice axes are divided into two types: Type 1 and Type 2. These types make a distinction between basic and technical ice axes.

This distinction is made using different tests:

- Shaft center-load pull test
- Shaft insertion strength test
- Pick levering test

These tests are detailed in the diagrams here.




Pull Test

Type 1 Ice Axes

These ice axes have a lower strength requirement than Type 2 ice axes. They are generally used for skiing, glacier travel, and classic mountaineering. For Type 1 ice axes, no marking is required, but if there is any, the marking is: B.


Type 2 Ice Axes

These ice axes have the highest strength required by the standard. They are primarily used for technical mountaineering, ice climbing, and dry tooling. For Type 2 ice axes, markings are required. The marking is: T.

Lighting performance as defined by the ANSI/PLATO FL 1 protocol

Petzl has chosen to comply with the ANSI (American National Standards Institute) protocol to measure and demonstrate the lighting performance and burn times of our headlamps. This voluntary move allows users to easily compare the lighting performance and water resistance of different headlamp models using standardized criteria.

Lighting Performance: How Is It Measured?



• Brightness (lumens)

This measurement is taken between 30 and 120 seconds after the headlamp is turned on. It indicates the maximum light output, when the lamp is first turned on, using new batteries.



• Lighting distance (meters)

This is the maximum distance between the lamp and the location where only 0.25 lux of illumination remains. The measurement is taken when the lamp is turned on, using new batteries. Lighting distance depends directly on brightness, but mainly on the shape of the beam.




• Burn time (hours)

This corresponds to the length of time during which lighting is optimal. It is measured 30 seconds after the lamp is turned on and for as long as the lamp takes to drop to 10 % of maximum light output.



• Reserve lighting (outside scope of ANSI/PLATO FL 1 protocol)

In addition to these measures, Petzl offers reserve lighting. Reserve lighting provides minimum light level for walking. However, the light may not be sufficient for fast-paced activities (such as running, mountain biking, or skiing).

Watertightness: What do the IP ratings on Petzl headlamps mean?

A headlamp's resistance to solids and/or liquids is indicated by its IP rating. This index classifies the level of protection offered by equipment against intrusions by solids (e.g. dust) and liquids (e.g. water, oil).



Rating complies with the majority of headlamp uses, in rain, snow, or humidity. All Petzl headlamps are at least IPX4 rated (weather resistant).



Rating indicates the headlamp is waterproof to in up to 1 meter of fresh water for 30 minutes. The e+LITE headlamp is IPX7 rated.



Rating indicates the headlamp is dustproof and waterproof in up to 1 meter of fresh water for 30 minutes. DUO RL, DUO S, ARIA 2 RGB and ARIA 1 RGB headlamps are rated IP67.



Rope Access and Confined Space

Rope access work often involves environments at significant height. Work done in confined spaces entails challenges related to the lack of space and lack of means of autonomous progression.



Tree Care

Not all tree work can be done using exterior means such as elevated platforms or ladders. In this case, to move and work, the arborist uses rope progression techniques.



Framing and Roofing

At this type of work site, the risk of slipping and falling is higher. A fall-arrest system must therefore be installed to guard against these hazards.





Self-Rescue

A firefighter who finds themselves trapped inside a burning structure must be prepared for self-evacuation and have the appropriate equipment on hand.



Hazardous Areas

Where there is risk of explosion, the hazardous locations are classified by zone (ATEX and/or HAZLOC). All of the materials used must therefore conform with current regulations for this type of zone.





Maintenance and Workshops

Professionals working at concerts and shows, in workshops, in maintenance, or in the energy and networks sector all require practical and lightweight headlamps on a daily basis.



Tactical, Special Forces

Tactical operations in a hostile environment require maximum safety in every situation, so being able to count on the quality and performance of the equipment is essential.



Exploring New Horizons

Accidents in Mountain Sports Improving prevention methods with scientific research

Since 2012, the Petzl Foundation has supported a multidisciplinary research collective with the goal of improving knowledge about accidents in mountain sports. In May 2022, a doctoral thesis financed by the Petzl Foundation was able to shed light on the issue, review victim profiles, and arrive at a better understanding of the circumstances conducive to accidents in the mountains.

Three years of doctoral research led by Maud Vanpoulle, made it possible to identify the recurring circumstances at the origin of accidents in mountaineering and ski touring, the contributing factors to an accident situation, and the profiles of those most affected. To achieve this, she relied on data from rescue operations in the French mountains, collected by the French National Mountain Safety Observation System (SNOSM), accounts from the SERAC online database via camptocamp.org, and the results of a survey about relationship to risk, supported by 2100 responses.

With close to 68,000 rescues reported between 2008 and 2018, SNOSM is currently the biggest data source in France for mountain incidents. However, when it comes to comprehending and conveying the vast complexity of scenarios that lead to accidents in the mountains, the rescue database has its limitations. That's why Maud Vanpoulle was also interested in using

the collaborative SERAC database that was added to camptocamp.org in 2016 to collect personal accounts of those involved in accidents in the mountains.

Vanpoulle also shed light on the different relationships to risk held by mountaineers by identifying three dimensions around which they position themselves to give meaning to their commitment to the mountains:

- Acceptance and evaluation of risk
- Vulnerability linked to doubts about their ability to manage the situation
- Sense of control and a willingness to manage risk




